
### Things to know: Vocabulary

<b>Binary</b>	Either-Or Categories	Lesbian Gay Heterosexual Bisexual	Biological Sex of male or female; Transgender
<b>Non-Binary</b>	Continuum/ Fluidity	Pansexual Queer	Genderqueer Transgender

### Things to know: The Role Identity Plays

Popular Script	Christian Script
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Attractions and feelings signal</b> a naturally-occurring <b>distinction and are a defining identity element</b> between sexualities and genders.</li> <li>2. <b>Attractions and feelings are the core</b> of who you are, and behavior is an extension of that core.</li> <li>3. Living out your sexual &amp; gender identity, including behavior that matches who you “really are,” is <b>crucial for your fulfillment.</b></li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Unwanted attractions and feelings don’t signal</b> a categorical distinction among types of people nor are they a defining identity element, but is one of many human experiences that are “not the way it’s supposed to be.”</li> <li>2. You can <b>choose to center your identity</b> around other aspects of your experience, including your identity in Christ, biological sex, life’s vocation/calling, and so on.</li> <li>3. The most compelling aspect of personhood for the Christian is one’s <b>identity in Christ.</b> All other aspects of identity and life fall under the authority of this one.</li> </ol>

What if I'm questioning my gender identity or sexual orientation?


## Am I alone?
