Why minister the blessing?

- The blessing of God is brought near through the ministration of others.
- "Who" ministers the blessing matters. Wives, in particular, have credibility with their husbands as well as mothers with their children.
- God's blessing includes healthy facts and feelings. It will help him have a proper relationship to the ministry.

ACCFS

How to minister the blessing?

- 1. Spend time listening for God's blessing.
- 2. Receive it for yourself.
- 3. Put it into words and in a manner that your husband will hear.
- 4. Share it with fact and feeling.
