

Identity Statement Activity

An identity statement is a statement that concisely articulates who you are. As a template for the statement consider answering these five questions.

1. What did God do for you?
2. Who is God to you?
3. Who are you to God?
4. What effect does this have on you?
5. How will you serve Him as a result?

While these questions are straightforward enough, time should be spent in investigation. Remember, identities are unique. Thus, your identity statement will look differently from the identity statements of others. Consider folding in ideas from the questions below.

- A. What are your spiritual gifts?
- B. Who are your heroes?
- C. What mottoes, scriptures or sayings significantly guide your life?
- D. What lies do you struggle with that should be countered in this statement?
- E. What meaning does your first, middle or last names have?
- F. What legacy do you wish to leave? How do you wish to be remembered?

Example:

I am not abandoned; I have been selected. I am not rejected; I am accepted. God has adopted me to be His forever son and He is glad. In His example, I am a servant to my wife. I unconditionally love my children. I am a receiver of people just like Jesus was. I will be remembered as one who lived with hope.
